Her painstaking efforts to include each and every detail and embellishment produced an awe-inspiring collection not often seen in productions of the Nutcracker.

The Miller Marley Youth Ballet Company feels so fortunate to have had a designer of Elaine's expertise at the helm. Elaine's talents and friendship will be missed by many.

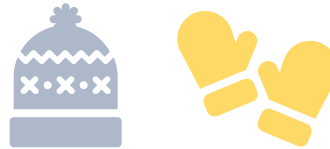
