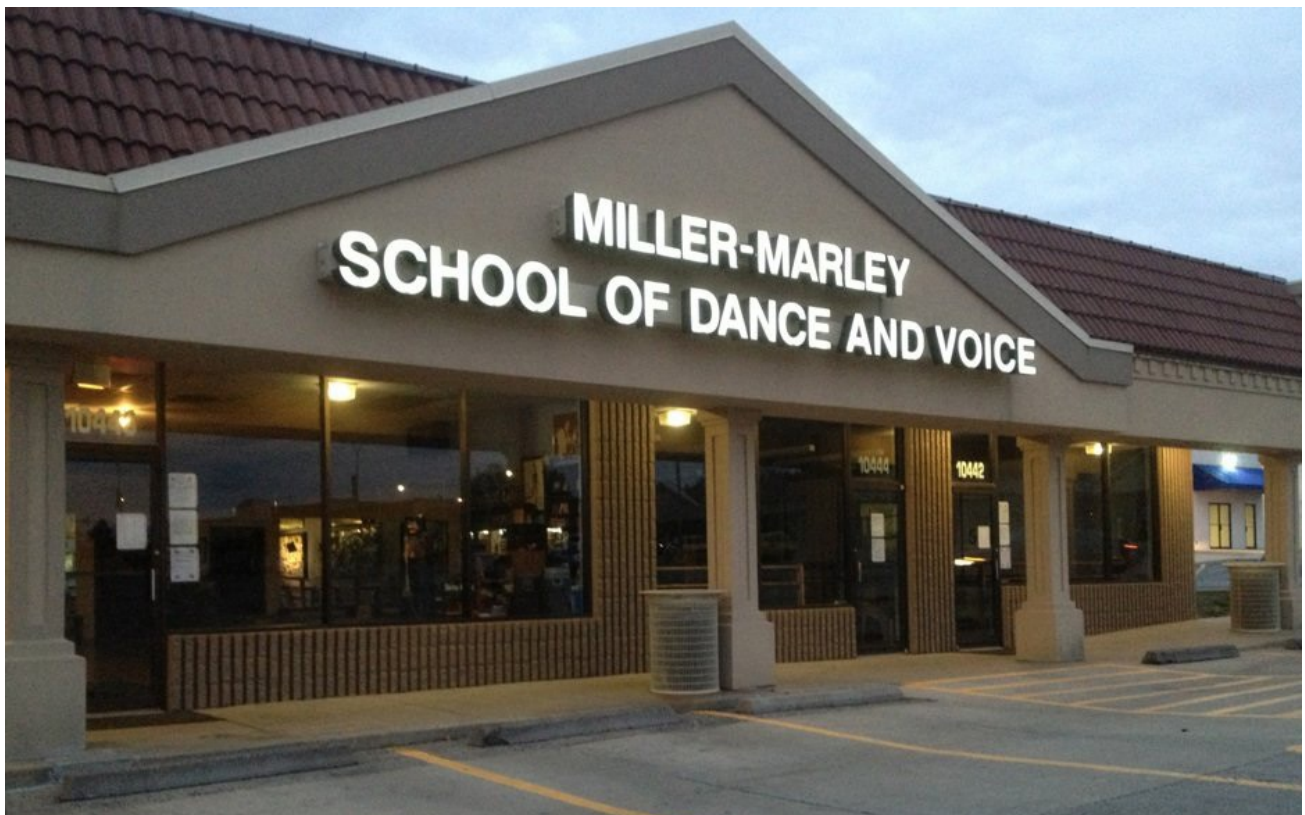

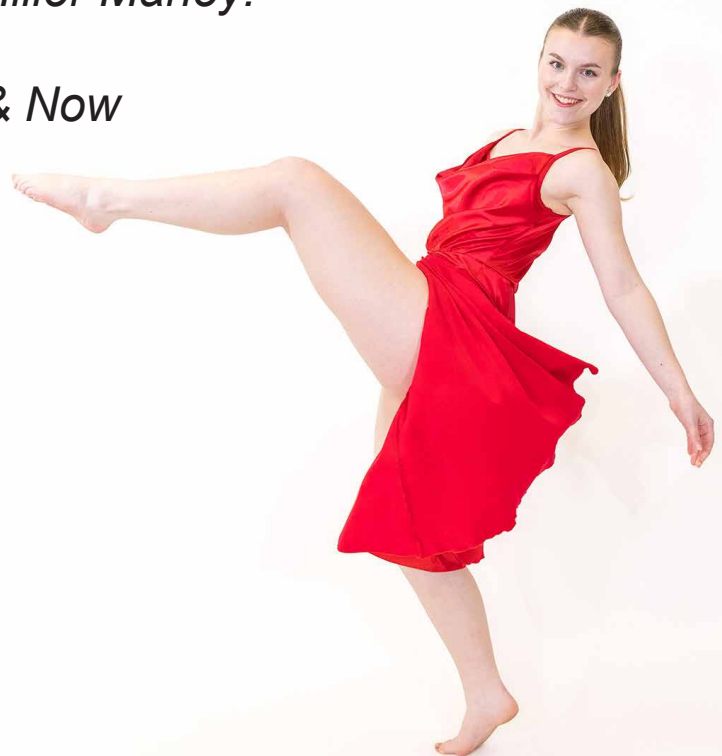
### Delaney Davis

## Kieran Ford

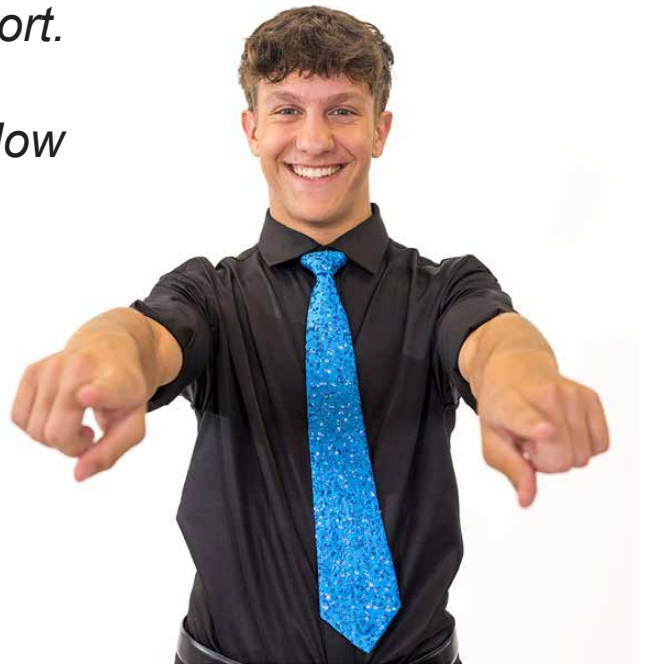
