As you and your family consider participation in our *Recital for Future Stars* 2026 event, we are requesting that each family **complete the Recital for Future Stars 2026 Online Form** to indicate your participation in this event and place your costume order. An online form will need to be completed/submitted for ALL enrolled students who qualify for this recital. Our Online Form will be available for your response/registration on Monday, November 10th. Student participation in this event is due by Monday, December 1st.

Click on the link provided. The form will offer information regarding your dancer's individual costume fees and performance fees. A fill-in is available to type your dancer's name as you would like it to appear in the recital program. Look carefully when selecting your dancer's recital class; the class day and time are identified for your convenience.

Participation in the *Recital for Future Stars* is always an option. If you choose **NOT** to participate, select the "No, I will not be participating in the Recital for Future 2026" button at the end of the form.

Dancers are not required to perform with **ALL** of their classes in the Recital for Future Stars 2026, but may place an order for a costume in the classes they want to perform in. STUDENTS: Communicating your class preferences to your teachers will help your teacher plan for this end-of-season performance.

Costume Fees

Costume Fees are priced based on sizing, materials, and company costs. Costume Fees for this performance will vary from \$85 to \$100.

Costume Fees for students participating in the *Recital for Future Stars 2026* will be posted and collected through autopay beginning on **Mon. Dec. 1**st **thru Mon. Dec. 8**th. If you are purchasing 2-4 or more costumes for this event and would prefer to split your costume total into two payments, a second split-fee costume payment can be set for **Thurs. Jan 8**th. Please see the Office Staff or contact <u>pam@millermarley.com</u> to request this payment arrangement for your account.

Costume measurements will begin the week of **Monday**, **December 1**st, **through Saturday**, **December 6**th. Measurements are taken and recorded for every student as a reference in Studio Pro.

COSTUME FEES ARE NEVER REFUNDED AFTER A COSTUME HAS BEEN ORDERED.

Costume Fees cannot be refunded once ordered; the costume is yours.

The following classes will **NOT** be in the *Recital for Future Stars* 2026 performances: PC Leaps & Turns class; PBT classes, Pre-Tumbling (4 & 5 yr.), Beginning Tumbling Aerials, Teen / Adults only classes.

Performance Fees

Performance Fees are monies that are used to offset the cost of the recital production. These expenses include the performing arts facility, additional expenses for stagehands, technical and lighting design needs, security, backdrop rentals, and MORE.

- The Performance Fee for the first student in one show is \$100.00.
- A second student from the same family in one show is an additional \$80.00.
- For each additional student from the same family is an additional \$60.00.
- If your child happens to be scheduled in more than one performance, NO additional fee will be charged.

Performance Fees will be due and charged starting **Monday**, **January 12**th, **through Thursday**, **January 15**th.

If a family needs to withdraw from the recital, performance fees can be refunded through Thursday, April 30th.

NO PERFORMANCE FEE REFUNDS will be granted after Sunday, May 1st.

On Stage Spacing Rehearsal

A theatre spacing rehearsal will be scheduled on the morning of Saturday, May 23rd, and/or Sunday, May 24th, on the Lied Center of Kansas stage. A rehearsal schedule will be available at a later date. ALL classes will be scheduled to perform in one show at 5:00 pm on Saturday, May 23rd, or Sunday, May 24th.

Reserved Ticket Prices

Reserved Ticket Seating will be available through the Lied Center of Kansas Ticket Office. Ticket costs are \$26, \$31, and \$36 - date for tickets to go LIVE TBD. Watch your email for more information.
