PLEASE label all shoes and dance belongings with your child's first and last name. This will benefit your dancer if their personal belongings are left behind or end up in the Lost & Found.

General Student Attire Guidelines

To present a professional image, students should come to class dressed in the proper dance attire as follows:

- Dancers should always wear a cover-up when going to and from dance studios.
- Hair should be pulled back and out of the dancer's face. A classical ballet bun is required for all ballet classes.
- Label all dance bags, shoes, water bottles, and miscellaneous apparel with the student's first and last name.
- Please note that preferences as to specific shoes and clothing may vary among instructors and age groups. Check the list below to determine if your child's instructor has certain requirements pertaining to attire.
- Bracelets, necklaces, dangling earrings, fit bits, watches, elastic around the wrist, or any other accessories other than those listed above are prohibited.
